Lonnie Joe Rayl died Friday June 24th at 12:16 PM at the age of 65 years old, in Bartlesville, OK.

Married Rhonda Jean Swank on June 22, 1986 had 2 children, Tabitha and Timothy, and was faithfully married

for 25 years. He was a former member of First Assembly of God Church in Bartlesville as a child; First Baptist Church in Dewey, OK, later Tuxedo Assembly of God in Bartlesville, Encouraging Word/Friday Nite Church, Redeemer Lutheran Church and Warriors for Christ. He also frequently attended Night Watch of Bartlesville until he became ill, and loved God with all of his heart, mind and soul. He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents Rhoda and Harry Rayl, and maternal grandparents Fannie and George Booth. His Mother Ila died in 1999 and His Father died in 2008.
