Louis James Mauk, 94, passed away Tuesday, June 28, at the Nowata Nursing Center in Nowata, OK. He was born December 6, 1916 at Vinton, in Cowley County, Kansas. He was the son of Erick and Eva Gayle (Smith) Mauk. He attended schools in Kay County, Oklahoma, and in Emporia, Kansas.

He served in World War II as a member of the U.S. Army, serving in the 42nd Rainbow Division, Field Artillery, from 1940 to 1945 and saw action in the European Theatre under General Eisenhower's command.

He married the former Roberta Maxine Cleghorn at Winfield, Kansas on July 10, 1942. After his honorary discharge from service, he farmed in Nowata County and then in the Winfield and Arkansas City area. He later bought the Feed and Seed Mill on Madison Street in Arkansas City. After retiring in 1977, he and his wife traveled a few years before establishing a home in Harlingen, Texas and Grove, Oklahoma. He was residing in Nowata, Oklahoma at the time of his death.

There will be an open visitation at the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel in Nowata on Thursday afternoon until 7:30 P.M. Funeral services will be at 2 P.M. on Friday, the 1st day of July, 2011 in the Chapel of Trout Funeral Home in Ponca City, OK. James Sherrod of Narden, Oklahoma will officiate. Burial will be in the Newkirk Cemetery at Newkirk, Oklahoma. Family and friends will gather at the funeral home at 1 P.M. Friday, prior to the beginning of the

services.

Mr. Mauk is survived by one brother, Calvin Burnworth Mauk of Farmington, New Mexico, and two sisters, Myrtle May Fortune of Hillsboro, Ohio and Adeline Gayle Stanart and her husband, H.L. Stanart of Nowata, Oklahoma, plus numerous nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his wife, his parents, one brother, Alvin Daniel Mauk, and six sisters, Florence Evelyn Beard, Caroline Glenna Steyer, Juanita Dorothy Beaupre, Margery Irene Pendergraft, Alvena Bell Smith, and Hazel Katrina Hodges.
