



## Loyal Edward Henson

October 26, 1923 - February 5, 2020

Loyal Edward Henson, 96, of Barnsdall, Oklahoma went to with the Lord on February 5, 2020, at his residence in Barnsdall.

Loyal Edward Henson was born on October 26, 1926, in Barnsdall to Nathan Edward Henson and Pearl Catherine (Miller) Henson. He attended and graduated from Barnsdall High School.

Loyal later joined the Navy in 1942 and served on the Minneapolis from 1942 to 1946. After returning home, he met and married Mary Ella Wilkerson on May 25, 1946, and they were married for seventy-three years. Later, he joined the Army National Guard in Pawhuska, Oklahoma an artillery unit. When the Korea War broke out, the unit was called to Japan and he served from 1950 to 1952. After returning home from Korea he served as a deacon in the First Baptist Church of Barnsdall. He helped with mission work by preaching at Avant, Nelagoney, Pershing, and Wolco until they became established. Loyal worked for Phillips Research Center in Bartlesville from May 1955 to July 1985.

Loyal is preceded in death by his parents; his wife; two brothers, Raymond Henson and Kenneth Henson; and two sisters, Vinie Hatfield and Ruby Louise Turman.

Loyal is survived by his three daughters, Glenda McCauley of Barnsdall, Brenda McKinney and husband Joe of Kiefer, Oklahoma and Christa Brumley and husband Jeff of Tulsa, Oklahoma; five grandsons; eight great grandchildren; two great great grandchildren; one brother, Robert Henson and

wife Margie of Barnsdall; several nieces, nephews, and a host of other relatives and friends.

A memorial service will be at 11:00 am Tuesday, February 18, 2020, at the Barnsdall First Baptist Church.
