Mrs. Lucille Edith Larison Harrington, 95, a longtime resident of Nowata County, passed away on Saturday, October 22, 2011.

Lucille began this life December 1, 1915 in Warsaw, Missouri. Her parents were Lemuel and Ethel (Wickliff) Larison. Her family moved to Nowata County when she was 4 years old. She attended school at Armstrong and Delaware. She married Alva R. (Nig) Harrington on December 24, 1935 in Alluwe, Oklahoma. They moved to El Dorado, Kansas for 4 years, later returning to south of Nowata on their small farm. She worked for 15 years as a nurse's aide for Osage Nursing Home. After her husband's death she stayed on their place taking care of the yard and raising a garden. She also did some volunteer work.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Alva R. on November 27, 1988, her parents and 2 brothers, Elmer and Walter Larison.

Lucille is survived by a sister, Barbara Harrington of Nowata, a son Raymond Harrington and wife Elisa of Wichita, Kansas, three daughters, Ruth King of Oklahoma City, Betty McGill of Nowata and Bonnie Friddle and her husband John of Nowata, 10 grandchildren, 20 great grandchildren and 10 great great

grandchildren.

Funeral services for Mrs. Harrington will be held at 11 A.M. Wednesday at the Nowata Memorial Park Cemetery with Rev. Wendell Abbott of the First Church of God officiating and under the direction of the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home.
