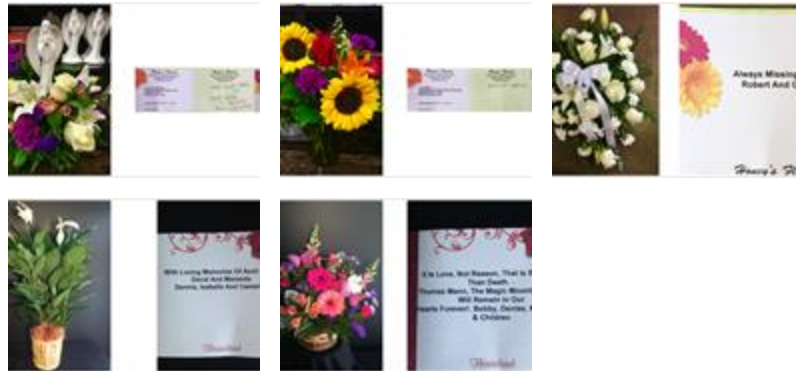

Thank you too for Carl, it didn't work out with him for me but, I did, and do love him, and know he was meant to be my husband, so that meant you were meant to be my mom in law... and I wish I had been able to let you know how precious you were here on earth to folks. I m so grateful to have known you Mom. you are one in a million. hope you like the flowers I sent. rest in peace with Jesus and we who know Jesus will see you very soon, xx
