She was given swim lessons there by a swimming instructor.

Among the memories she shared was as a young child traveling in a car with a rumble seat that is where she sat. She loved to travel with her parents in that car. Lurene attended school in Bartlesville thru 12 grade. She worked as a secretary for HC Price and later in life worked for Paul Murphy as a bookkeeper and Hostess.

Lurene saw a lot of changes during her life time. She saw horse and buggy days to space ships fling to the moon. Lurene was an active member of Highland Park Baptist Church for 40 years until her health problems no longer allowed.

Lurene is survived by a niece and nephew, Lee and Bill Hill; a great-niece Cindy Webster and great-great-niece Mahgon Youngblood and great-great-nephew Mahlon Hill.

“ I am Stephen George Hays, only living son (of 3) of Lurene Pearl Cockriel & Edwin Alvin (Tuck) Hays. My older brother (never named) died at birth, My younger brother, Larry Asher Hays died of aids many years ago as a result of a nervous breakdown & being placed in a mental hospital with men when he was approximately 7 or 8 years of age, at the time of our parents divorce. I never saw him again but spoke to him by phone, once, approximately 30 years ago. I fought the attempt to place me in the Masonic Orphanage in Guthrie, Ok and ended up being placed in 2 private boarding schools over the next 2 years. My father was "blackballed" by the Masonic Lodge because of the divorce and remarried soon after. I am 68 yrs. of age, retired, have a wonderful wife of 50 yrs. and two grown sons in their late 40's, with 5 grandchildren between the two. I doubt anyone will read this but I feel compelled to make a brief and very incomplete entry as the last living member of the original family having found out by an act of fate after searching my mothers name on Google.
