Marguerite (Maggie) Garrett went on to be with Lord November 27, 2016 at the age of 90. She had been a resident of the Osage Nursing Center where she received very special and loving care for almost three months.

Maggie was born March 25, 1926 in Bartlesville, OK to Carl and Nellie Hedman. She grew up in Dewey, OK with three brothers, Carl Jr., Leonard, and Arvid and attended Dewey Public Schools. She married Blaine Garrett on March 20, 1945. They lived and raised their two daughters on a ranch in Nowata county. Maggie was a loving and devoted wife and mother.
