Marjorie “Margie” Ruth Leigh (née Bloom), 69, of Bartlesville, OK, died July 11, 2015, of complications resulting from a heart attack. Margie was born on August 17th, 1945, in Coodys Bluff, Oklahoma, to Ruth Elizabeth and Amos Leroy Bloom, who named her after the title character in the TV show, “My Little Margie.” One of six children, she grew up in Nowata, OK, and graduated from Nowata High School in 1963. She attended Bartlesville Business College and then worked for Phillips Petroleum Company as an administrative assistant until her retirement. She then volunteered for Meals on Wheels and Jane Phillips Memorial Hospital. She enjoyed walking, gardening, bicycling, travel, bird watching, and the tranquility of nature.

In 1968 she wed Charles Hubbard Leigh and together they had two children, James Edward (1969) and Mary Beth (1971).

Marjorie was preceded in death by her parents Ruth Elizabeth Bloom and Amos Leroy Bloom.
