David Holt Magee, 44, and Marquita R. Magee, 45, of Barnsdall, died on the evening of Saturday, June 18, 2016 as a result of a motorcycle/auto accident on Highway 62 near Eureka Springs, Arkansas.

Funeral services for David and Marquita will be held at 10 A.M. on Friday, June 24, 2016 at the Barnsdall School Gymnasium with Johnny Jones and Stuart Henderson officiating for the services. Interment for David Magee will be in the Ethel Reece Cemetery at Barnsdall. Marquita Magee will be cremated and her cremated remains will be placed at David's gravesite.

Funeral services are under the direction of the Stumpff Barnsdall Funeral Home.

Visitation for friends and family will be held at the Stumpff Barnsdall Funeral Home on Wednesday and Thursday until 8 P.M. each day.

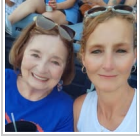

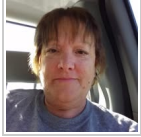

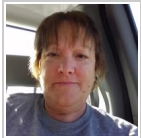
