He continued his education earning a Master of Divinity with a concentration in Biblical Studies graduating in December 2016 from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Bud met the love of his life and in April 1976 he moved in and fell in love with the girl next door. Brenda and he knew they were the perfect pair for each other from the beginning and were married January 28, 1977.

Bud worked his early years for K.C. Asphalt alongside worked his stepfather Bill Barth who left a massive impact on his life to be a better man. He also worked for a time at Kings Butcher, and Bluestem Foundry. Once married he was hired at Phillips Petroleum Comp. Then later Chevron where he retired from in May 2021.

Bud accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior and was a completely changed man. He began serving as a Royal Ranger teacher, deacon then preaching and singing in a jail ministry through Bluestem Baptist Church in Dewey along with supply preaching to surrounding churches. When Bluestem
