Marvin Duane Warehime, 84 passed away March 25, 2023. Marvin was the youngest child of nine born to Dewey Warehime and Hazel (Stanton) Warehime On August 22, 1938. Marvin grew up in the Rush Springs and Okesa Oklahoma areas and graduated from College High School in Bartlesville. He began his work career in accounting at REDA pump and worked there until he left to pursue his own personal business in bookkeeping and tax service that he thrived at for over 60 years until retiring a few years ago.
