Mavis Clopp, 87, of Bartlesville, passed away on June 2, 2021 at Bartlesville Health and Rehap Community after her battle with colon cancer and a stroke.

Mavis was born on October 31, 1933 in the Memorial Hospital in Bartlesville, Oklahoma to Mose Cunningham and Irene (Southerland) Cunningham.

As an active homemaker, Mavis enjoyed sewing, gardening, canning, and cooking along with family camping and fishing trips. She helped with the Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and holiday school parties and fund raisers.

In addition to her parents, Mavis was preceded in death by her sister, Norma West; son, David Clopp; grandson, Lee Offitt; and son-in-law Flint Kyler.
