Michael Allen Lord, 71, resident of Bartlesville, died at 5:50 PM on Sunday, May 12, 2013 at his residence.

Memorial services will be held at 2:00 PM on Thursday, May 16, to 13 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel. Interment of cremation will be in the Ft. Gibson National Cemetery at a later date, under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Michael Allen Lord was born January 13, 1942 at Muskogee, Oklahoma; his parents were Eugene and Christine (Wallace) Lord. He was raised and received his early education in Hanover, Illinois, and graduated from Oktaha High School at Oktaha, Oklahoma in 1960. Michael entered the U.S. Navy and served for five years as electronic technician. After his military services he always had a passion to hike the Appalachian Trail and did so for thirty-two days. Michael was married to Pauline Kay Sutton on August 30, 1963 at Muskogee, Oklahoma. Michael was employed with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company as an engineer for twenty-six years. After retirement he attended Tulsa Community College where he received his degree in Assistant Physical Therapy. Michael worked as a PTA at Jane Phillips Medical Center and Elder Care in Bartlesville. He also taught and help originate classed at Tri-

County Technological Center in Telecommunication and Networking.

Survivors include; his wife Pauline Kay Lord of the family home in Bartlesville; one daughter Kristen Palmer and her husband Dr. Mark Palmer of Columbia, Missouri; one brother Glen Lord of Muskogee and two grandsons Patrick and Nicolas Palmer.
