Mr. Michael Dennis Duggan, 65, of Bartlesville, died at 7:43 p.m. on Tuesday, December 13, 2011 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center.

Funeral services for Mr. Duggan will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 20, 2011 at the Bartlesville Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, located at 1501 SE Swan Drive. Interment will be in the Mount Hope Cemetery at Independence, Kansas where the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Honor Guard will accord honors at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 20, 2011. Funeral arrangements are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Casket escorts will include members of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Honor Guard.

Mr. Duggan was born in Tulsa, Oklahoma on August 11, 1946, the son of Albert (A.C) Duggan and Inez (Stickney) Duggan. He grew up and received

his education in Tulsa where he graduated from Webster High School. He was married to Sheryl Ann Sewell in Tulsa on May 20, 1966. He was employed as a Tulsa Police Officer for several years prior to becoming a State Trooper with the Oklahoma Highway Patrol in 1970. Mr. and Mrs. Duggan made their home at various locations in Oklahoma during his career with the patrol until his retirement in 1990. Following his retirement, he was then employed with American Airlines in Tulsa until his second retirement in 2009 as an Electronics Technician. Mr. and Mrs. Duggan made their home in Owasso for 21 years until moving to Bartlesville in 2009. He received his Bachelors Degree in Law Enforcement from Northwestern Oklahoma State University at Alva, Oklahoma in 1977 and had been active as a civilian aviation pilot. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, the Retired Troopers Association, and truly enjoyed his children, grandchildren, and traveling.

Mr. Duggan is survived by his wife, Sheryl Duggan of Bartlesville, his sons and daughter-in laws Daniel Duggan and his wife Crisstina of Tumwater, Washington, and Terry Duggan and his wife Jean of Colorado; as well as two daughters and son-in-laws, Kimberly Young and her husband Chris of Tulsa, and Mendy Duggan and her husband James Ferguson of Stillwater; as well as one sister, Judy Powell of Broken Arrow and three grandchildren, Aaron Young, Wyatt Baty, and Madelyn Baty. He was preceded in death by his parents.
