I remember we got in a fight and he bloodied my nose and I went home crying and told my Dad. Punch him back in the nose was Dad's advice. So I did and I bloodied Mikes nose. He can't remember me bloodying his nose but he remembers bloodying mine, so I reminded him, a lot. That wasn't the last fight we fought but it did seal our friendship. We fought the neighbor kids but differences were resolved and we would play backyard football, baseball, basketball. or build forts in the hedgerows. Mike moved to Oklahoma and I left for the service and Viet Nam after graduation. I visited with Mike after the service and sad to say we didn't have much in common, which is common for people who grow up and grow apart. I remember going to Ralph Baums on Harry St. in Wichita with Mike in his Cherry Red '58 Chevy short bed pickup with the wrap around rear window. He bought racing slicks for it and burnt those babies up. We connected a few years back and both of us had matured a lot and reconnected our friendship. While visiting Carols folks in Oregon Mike and Carol stopped by to visit in McCall. What a beautiful couple, I really thought a lot of them and still do. Knowing Mike as a teenager and always thinking him being the same person as he was I was very pleased and impressed on how wise Mike had become. We talked and I even took his advice and noted what Mike learned in his family life and work life. I experienced a lot of death and misery in the war and Mike could relate to what he had seen as a fireman. We talked last October and Mike told me if he caught this COVID he knew it would be the end. I would like to express my deep gratitude to his daughter who sacrificed her kidney to keep her father alive which resulted in me reconnecting with Mike again. It was a true blessing for me. My plan for the pearly gates is to come in with a big belly slide and a YEEEHAAW shout out. I'm sure ol' Michael Dean Gann will be right there waiting for me, " you okay Billy; well good cause there's a Ralph Baums burger joint here and they got giant chili cheeseburgers and real strawberry lemonade. Lets go buddy. Rest in Peace until then Mike. God Bless your family!
