Mickey Ann (Crawford) Ramirez, 72, passed away on Wednesday, October 23, 2024. A beloved wife, mother, and friend, Mickey's life was a testament to dedication, love, and service. Memorial services will be at Bartlesville First Church on Saturday, November 9th, at 2:00pm to celebrate her life and her memory.

Mickey was born on October 25, 1951, to Lloyd and Ann Crawford in Pawhuska, OK. She graduated high school from Bartlesville Sooner High in 1969 and was also in the first graduating class of Tri-County Technology Center. Her journey of service began when she enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1973, a calling she embraced wholeheartedly. She served on Active Duty until 1977, at which time she transitioned to the Air Force Reserves, continuing her service until 1985. Her commitment to her country was matched only by her dedication to her family and friends.

She married Reyes Ramirez on October 15th, 1983, in Houston, TX. Together, they were blessed with their daughter, Bonnie Anne, in May 1985 and their son, Lloyd Anthony, in November 1987.

After moving home to Bartlesville with her family in 1987, Mickey explored several fulfilling career paths including as a realtor and an executive assistant for several companies. In her retirement, she found joy volunteering at

Tuesday House, where she made many lasting friendships. Mickey will be remembered for her warmth, generosity, and the kindness she extended to everyone she met.

Mickey is preceded in death by her loving parents, her nephew Jimmy Crawford, and great-nephew Tristan Powell.
