Myra Lou Woodard, 68, of Skiatook, formerly of Bartlesville, died peacefully on November 30, 2012 at St. John Medical Center in Tulsa.

Born February 15, 1944, in Bartlesville, she lived in Moultrie, Georgia, while her father served as a pilot in the Korean War. The family returned to Oklahoma in 1955, and Myra graduated from Dewey High School in 1962. She attended Coffeyville Junior College. She was employed as a legal secretary and later was a full-time homemaker. She is best remembered as a devoted mother, grandmother and a loyal friend.
