Nichole Josephine "Nikki" Hathcoat, 17, of Nowata, died early Friday, June 6, 2014 in a traffic accident on Highway 169 near South Coffeyville.

Funeral services for Nikki will be held at 10 A.M. on Thursday, June 12, 2014 at the Nowata High School Gymnasium with Brenda Hathcoat officiating. Interment will be in the Nowata Memorial Park Cemetery directed by the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home.

Casket escorts will include Saxon Kuehn, Jeremy Boren, Devon Hathcoat, Britton Townsend, David Richards and Blaine Travis. Honorary casket escorts will include Joey Kuehn, Ty Smith, Dalton Lanning, Cordell Jackson, Dillon Harrington, and Jesse Dotson.

Nikki was born in Bartlesville, Oklahoma on November 14, 1996 to Dwayne K. and Connie Jo (Forbes) Hathcoat. She grew up in Nowata and attended Nowata Schools thru the ninth grade and then transferred to the Oklahoma Union School where she had completed the 11th grade. While at Nowata Schools she had been active as a cheerleader and at Oklahoma Union she was her class president, was active in FFA, president of the prom committee and participated in the youth program of the Oklahoma State Grange. She was chosen to speak on behalf of the Oklahoma Union School to the

Oklahoma State Representatives. She had been employed at Rebecca's Day Care in South Coffeyville. She attended St. Paul Lutheran Church in Coffeyville and was loved by many friends and family members.

Nikki is survived by her father, Dwayne K. Hathcoat of Nowata, her mother, Connie Jo Masters and husband Kyle of Nowata, two brothers, Jeremy Boren and wife, Kammi of Chelsea and Devon Hathcoat of Nowata, her paternal grandparents, John and Barbara Yates of Nowata, three nephews, Jayson Boren, Jude Boren and Jeremyah Boren, her fiancé, Saxon Kuehn, , aunts and uncles, Debbie and Bob Klimec of Benbrook, Texas, Denzal and Patty Hathcoat of Nowata, David Hathcoat of Nowata, Dane and Deanna Mitchell, and another aunt, Kathy and many cousins.
