Mrs. Norma Lenora Jordan, 89, of Bartlesville, died at 1:25 A.M. on Sunday, February 22, 2015 at her home.

Funeral services for Mrs. Jordan will be held at 2 P.M. on Wednesday, February 25, 2015 in the East Sanctuary of the First Baptist Church with her son, Dr. Anthony L. Jordan officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

The Jordan family will receive guests for visitation at the Stumpff Funeral Home on Tuesday evening from 7 P.M. until 9 P.M.

Mrs. Jordan was born at Skiatook, Oklahoma on July 4, 1925 the daughter of Sherman J. Fritz and Ressie R. (Holt) Fritz. She grew up in various locations where her father was employed in the oil fields and she graduated from high school at Fairfax, Oklahoma. She was married to Aden Lee Roy Jordan on June 12, 1943 and they were employed by Douglas Aircraft in Tulsa during World War II. They later made their home in Skiatook and Owasso. Mrs. Jordan was active as a dental assistant and was also a church pianist in Skiatook for many years. They moved to the Bartlesville/Dewey area in the 1980's and Mr. Jordan preceded her in death on August 17, 1990. Mrs. Jordan was a member of the First Baptist Church in Bartlesville and as a

pastor's daughter, she always wrote notes of encouragement to all of her pastors.

Mrs. Jordan is survived by one daughter, Karolyn Kay Clark and husband Earl of Bartlesville, one son, Dr. Anthony L. Jordan and wife Polla of Oklahoma City, one brother, Kenneth Fritz and wife Dora Lee of Owasso, four grandchildren, Kendall Clark, Karey Hagar and husband Scott, Adrian Jordan and wife Janae and Alisha Jordan, and two great grandchildren, Kaylee Hagar and Savannah Hagar, and three sisters-in-law, Louise (Jordan) Miller and husband Jimmy, Wanda (Jordan) Smith and Betty (Jordan) Schofield and husband Joe and one brother-in-law Robert Jordan and wife Terry and many nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband she was also preceded in death by her parents.
