Norma Jean (Ball) Perrier, 96, of Barnsdall, OK, passed away peacefully on January 9, 2024. Born on January 10, 1928, in Osage County, she was the beloved daughter of Otis and Kittie Cleo Crain Ball. Norma's early education began in Phillipsburg, and she later moved with her family to Ochelata, where she completed grade school and began her high school journey. In her sophomore year, the family relocated to Shidler, Oklahoma, where she proudly was a member of the Shidler High School Class of 1946.

Following high school, Norma embarked on her professional journey at SW Bell Telephone Company in Bartlesville, OK, where she worked for a year and a half. She managed the Barnsdall Bloodmobile kitchen and opened and operated the Legion Mall at Post 227 from 1991 to 2006. Additionally, she served as an

Election Board Clerk for Barnsdall/Osage County, demonstrating her commitment to her community and civic duty.
