Olive Minnie 'Cook' Fromm went to be with the Lord on August 25, 2025, at 12:38 p.m.

Olive was born on June 7, 1949, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, to James and Elizabeth Cook. She was raised in Copan and graduated from Copan High School in 1967. Olive worked at Bartlesville Pharmacy until she met Al Fromm. After dating, they married in July 1971. The couple made their home in Tulsa, and their only child was born in 1974. Due to the long distance and separation, they divorced in 1977.

Olive worked for Applied Automation for 20 years, where she was a lead and taught classes in solder. In the late 1990s, Olive began working for Cessna and retired after 20 years.

She became a member of the Copan Methodist Church and served on the board.
