Mr. O. Phillip Kent Obituary

Mr. Oscar Phillip Kent, Jr. age 94, retired employee of the Engineering Department

for Phillips Petroleum company, and longtime Bartlesville resident died January

9, 2015 in Bartlesville.

Phillip was born on December 12, 1920 in Sulphur Springs, Texas,

the son of Oscar Phillip and Frances Helen (Thompson) Kent. He graduated from

Sulphur Springs High School in 1939. During World War II, he served in the United

States Air Corps and received the following campaign medals: American Campaign,

European African Middle Eastern and The Victory Medal. He attended East Texas State

Teacher's College, graduating in 1947 with a degree in mathematics.

Phillip and Fern Johnson were united in marriage on September 12, 1953 in Dallas,

Texas. During their forty-two years of marriage, Phillip and Fern traveled extensively

throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico and Europe. They have two surviving

daughters, Kathryn Ann (Kay) and husband, George A. Starkweather of Cookeville,

Tennessee and Carol Lynn and husband, Richard J. Stewart of Tulsa; five grandchildren,

Austin, Kent, Edward (Ted) Starkweather, and Benjamin and Jeffrey Stewart.

Phillip was an active participant in numerous local organizations. He served two terms

as president in the Bartlesville Genealogical Society. He also served as an Elder, First

Presbyterian Church, Bartlesville. As a member of East Cross United Methodist Church,

he taught Sunday school, chairman evangelism commission and member Board of

Concern Center.

After retirement, he volunteered for twenty-two years at the Jane Phillips Medical

Center and was a docent at Woolaroc Museum.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Fern, and special friend, Sylvia

Cranmer.
