A Celebration of Life will be held at 1:30 P.M. Saturday, January 30, 2021 at the First Wesleyan Church with Pastor Joe Colaw officiating. The service will be live streamed by the church.

On December 28, 2020, God called Pansy Stallings to her Heavenly home. Having developed a love for music early in life (at age three), Pansy was anointed with a very special musical talent, for which she credited her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Her challenge was to share HIS message through both piano and vocal music, as well as her personal testimony. Nothing thrilled her more than to sit at a piano and play the old gospel hymns that God placed in her head to share with thousands of beloved friends through Facebook Live and concerts. She never met a stranger and received love as easily as she gave it. Pansy had an infectious smile with a laughter to match. Her goal was to make every person feel special, loved, and prepared to meet Jesus Christ.

She encouraged everyone she met, whether through Facebook or in person, to repent of their sins; turn to Jesus; and have a personal relationship with HIM. Her signature slogan was "My life, my love, my passion."

Pansy constantly reminded her followers that “It’s not about us, it’s All About HIM.”

Due to the COVID pandemic and restrictions, efforts will be made to meet Pansy’s wish of having a Celebration of her Life. Honoring that wish, a notification will be made on her Facebook page, when final arrangements have been completed.
