Patricia Jeanne Schuck (Reale) of Lakeway, TX passed away Saturday, August 25, 2018 at her home surrounded by her family, after a decade long battle with numerous health problems. She was 76 years old.

Pat grew up in Barnsdall, OK and was the seventh of eight children. She attended Barnsdall High School, and shortly thereafter she married her first husband, Thomas William Murrie in 1959. Family was always her top priority and in April of 1960 they gave birth to their first children, twins Sherri and Terri. Two years later in January of 1962 her daughter Tammi was born. She cared and raised her daughters and followed Tom as work took him all over the US and they finally made it back home to Barnsdall, Oklahoma in the early 70's. Pat & Tom then bought and managed the local Murrie's Mini Mart along with their daughters. The success of the store was a testament to her tireless work ethic. During her free time Pat and the kids loved to ski at the lake and Pat loved to bowl.

Shortly after the children graduated high school Pat and Tom were divorced. Pat then moved to Jenks, Oklahoma and opened up a shoe store on Main street. Anyone who has ever known Pat or visited her house knows she loves shoes. Pat has always had a love for fashion. She spent many years perfecting her techniques as a seamstress, making many of her own cloths and that of her family. It was during this time she met the love of her life, William Mark Schuck.

Bill and Pat married in 1984, and Pat gained another daughter Ellen Patterson

Schuck. They moved to Connecticut and Pat spent her days working for Regency limousine company that served the greater New York City metropolis. During this time Bill and Pat were fortunate that Bill's work allowed them to travel all over the US. Bill was an avid golfer, and convinced Pat to take up the game. They truly enjoyed playing together. In their travels they had the good fortune to play many of the premier courses in the world. After a couple years in Connecticut they moved to Kingwood, Texas. This was very fortunate because it brought Pat and Bill within driving distance of their family. They would bring their grandchildren down to Houston for weeks at a time, playing golf, going to Astro's games, visiting NASA, the beach, and they were able to return to Oklahoma for holidays, birthdays, and graduations. Upon Bill's retirement in 1998 they moved to their last home in Lakeway, Texas, a suburb of Austin in the Texas Hill Country. They continued playing golf and focused their last years on spending time with their five grandchildren and later their six great grandchildren.

Pat is survived by her daughters, Sherri Ann Murrie of Spring TX, Tammi Sue Layton (Murrie) and husband Monty of Copan, and their children Sara Beth Gaches (McLaughlin) and her husband Travis, and their daughter Lia Beth, Tylan Jay Layton of OK and his fiancé Ryley Lawson, Ellen Patterson (Schuck) and husband Tony of Indianapolis, IN and their daughter Jessica Carrico, her grandson Jimmy Shaw and wife Beth of Bixby, OK and their children Noah, Ainsely, and Eden, grandson Stephen Shaw and wife Rachel of Rowlett, TX and their children Evelyn and Christian.

Pat was preceded in death by her husband, William Mark Schuck, daughter Terri Ann Shaw (Murrie), parents Patrick Nicholas Reale and Ida May Reale (Hickson), siblings Patrick, Mary, Catherine, Betty, Jerry, Carol, and David.

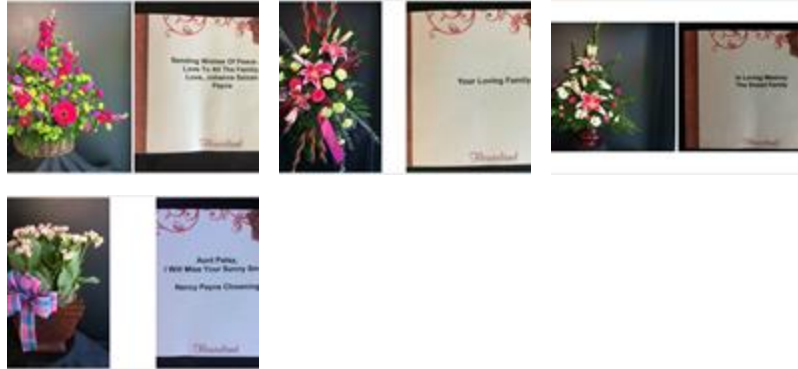
