Patricia Gaile Swant, 77, passed away on Thursday, May 19, 2016 at her home in Skiatook, Oklahoma. Pat was born on July 7, 1938 in Ada, Oklahoma. She graduated from Seminole High School in 1956 and continued on to Oklahoma State University where she received her degree in Accounting. She married Billy Jack Swant on January 6, 1958. Pat worked as a Certified Public Accountant and was a pioneer for women working in her field. She started her career at Arthur Young and Associates, where she climbed the ladder and was promoted to manager. Next, she served as Director of Taxes, Federal and Foreign at Phillips Petroleum and was one of the first women in the nation to hold such a position. She then moved on to Hilti, where she served as Director of Taxes Worldwide. Pat traveled the world during her career and paved the way for women to succeed in the workforce, a major source of pride for her and inspiration to her family. After leaving the corporate world, Pat continued to do tax work and consulting for numerous small businesses until her retirement. Pat also had many fulfilling hobbies. She was an avid duplicate bridge player, a gourmet cook, and enjoyed sewing, painting, and stained glass. Most of all, Pat loved spending time with her family. Pat is survived by her husband, Billy Jack Swant; her daughter, Susan Roberts and husband Rod; her son, Steven Swant and wife Pam; her grandchildren, Jennifer Donley, Sarah Stroud and husband Cody, Katherine Swant, Rachel Pickard, Evan Swant, and Jackson Swant; and her great-grandson, Samuel Stroud.
