Mrs. Pauline E. Holley, 89, resident of Nowata died at 10:40 A.M. on Friday in Nowata.

Funeral Services for Mrs. Holley will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Monday, October 12, 2015 in the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home Chapel, with Chaplain Kevin Webster of the Carter Hospice officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery in Nowata, directed by the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home.

Mrs. Holley was born September 6, 1926 at Snowball, Arkansas to Oren Wilford and Sarah Ann (Barnhart) LaRue. She came to Bartlesville as a young girl with her parents and was raised here receiving her education in Bartlesville Public Schools through 11th grade. She later completed her GED, and then received her LPN training at the Jane Phillips Hospital, where she graduated from nursing school in 1958. She was employed as a LPN at the Jane Phillips Medical Center for several years, and then later at the Nowata Hospital. She then worked at a clinic in Chelsea for several Doctors in their Clinic at Chelsea, and then finished her working career working for Dr. Frank Hester DVM at his Veterinary Clinic in Chelsea. She was married to Olen B. Holley on October 23, 1943 at Ochelata, Oklahoma. They made their home in Nowata County on a farm for several years, until she moved into town in Nowata in 1993; she made her home in Nowata since that time. She had

attended the Church of God of Prophecy in Bartlesville.

Mrs. Holley is survived by her daughter Larry Ann Holley of Rogers, Arkansas, three brothers and their spouses; Orville Frank Larue and Belle of Jay, Oklahoma, Gary Wayne LaRue and Barbara of Siloam springs, Arkansas, and Oren Wilford LaRue and Lorene of Springdale, Arkansas, and sister Edith Elaine Francis and husband Lealon of Ramona, Oklahoma, and numerous other nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents Oren Wilford and Sarah Ann LaRue, her husband Olen B. Holley in 2002, by six brothers; Earl, Jimmy, Fred, Kenneth, Roscoe, and Bob Larue, and three sisters Maxine, Mary, and Frances.
