Phillip Earl "PK" Keithley, 75, resident of rural Dewey, died at 3:40 AM on Sunday, February 2, 2014 in Bartlesville.

Funeral services will be held at 1:00 PM on Thursday, February 6, 2014 at White Rose Cemetery in Bartlesville. Graveside services and interment will be under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Phillip Earl "PK" Keithley was born November 23, 1938 in Nowata, Oklahoma to Earl Francis and Juanita Pauline (Reed) Keithley. He was raised and received his education in Nowata and graduated from Nowata High School in 1957.
