Rachel grew up in Porterville, CA where she graduated from Monache High School with high honors. She went on to attend Brigham Young University and earned her Bachelor's Degree. Rachel was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. At 21, she served 18 months in Toronto, Canada as a missionary. David and Rachel began their life together in Lehi, Utah and she soon started her work as a Cyto-Genetic Lab Technician. After 12 years in Utah, they moved to Bartlesville, Oklahoma where they have resided ever since.
