Ramona Veal "Mona" Crawford, 71, of Bartlesville, passed peacefully at her home on Wednesday, November 26, 2014 at 12:30 A.M.

Funeral services for Mona will be held at 2 P.M. on Saturday in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Pastor Orville Moody of the Rose Hill Community Baptist Church officiating. Interment will be in the Dewey Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

The Crawford family will receive guests for visitation at the Stumpff Funeral Home on Friday evening from 5 P.M. until 7 P.M.

Mrs. Crawford was born at St. Louis, Missouri on July 31, 1943 the daughter of Robert N. and Ramona June (Brewer) Harpole. She graduated from Thayer High School at Thayer, Missouri in 1961 and she was married to Robert E. Crawford in Thayer, Missouri on June 24, 1962. They made their home briefly in St. Louis until establishing their home north of Dewey in 1963. She retired from the county court house where she worked as the Secretary/Bailiff for the Honorable Judge John Lanning and the Honorable Judge Curtis DeLapp. She had also been employed in the jewelry and cosmetic departments at Dillard's. Mr. Crawford preceded her in death on November 1, 2001 and she continued her home north of Dewey until moving to Bartlesville six months ago. She was an avid sports fan, especially for the St. Louis Cardinals and the Oklahoma City Thunders. She loved to garden her flowers, sing, maintain hundreds of hummingbird feeders and enjoyed her family especially her grandchildren.

She was a member of the Rose Hill Community Baptist Church.
