Mr. Randy Guy Post, 55, of Caney, Kansas, died at 11:29 A.M. on Monday, September 3, 2018 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mr. Post will be held at 10 A.M. on Saturday, September 8, 2018 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel in Bartlesville. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery where military honors will be accorded by the United States Navy Honor Guard. Funeral services and interment are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory in Bartlesville.

Mr. Post was born on March 7, 1963 at Addison, Michigan the son of James and Pamela (Aaron) Post. He. Grew up in various states but primarily in California. Following his high school graduation on August 18, 1981 he entered the United States Navy in which he served until receiving his Honorable Discharge on August 31, 1996. Following his discharge, he moved to Coffeyville, Kansas where he was employed with BOC Gasses (now known as Linde) where he was currently employed as the plant manager. He moved to Caney, Kansas to make his home in 1999.

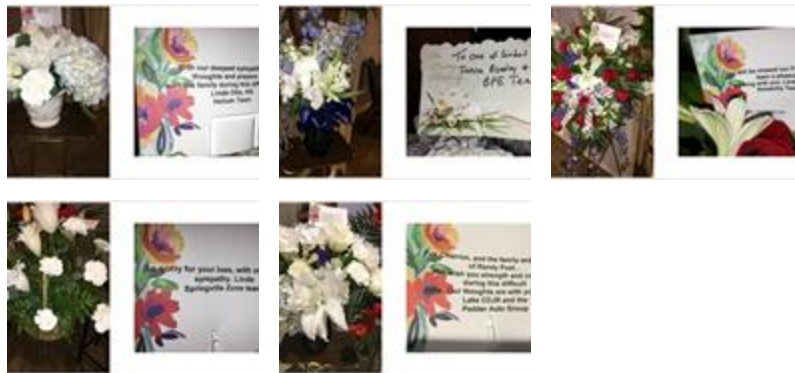
