



Ray Dwight Griffin

October 31, 1933 - September 2, 2012

Ray Dwight Griffin, 78, resident of rural Copan, Oklahoma, died Sunday, September 2, 2012, in Bartlesville.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 AM on Thursday, September 6, 2012, in the First Baptist Church of Copan, Oklahoma, with Rev. Willard Lyons officiating. Interment will be in the Dewey Cemetery under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Ray Dwight Griffin was born October 31, 1933 at Copan, Oklahoma, to Van Buren Clifton and Roxie Ann (Holt) Griffin. He was raised and received his education in Copan, graduating high school there in 1952. Following high school graduation, Ray entered the U.S. Navy where he was trained as a teletype repairman and sent to Guam where he was stationed for 18 months. After Guam, Ray was assigned to the USS Shangri La aircraft carrier where he performed teletype repair before receiving his honorable discharge in 1956. Ray and Greta Diane Trotter were married on March 15, 1957 at Copan making their home there since 1957. Ray was employed with Phillips Petroleum Company for 33 years before retiring as the evaluation laboratory supervisor at the Phillips Plastics Technical Center in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Survivors include his wife Greta Diane Griffin of the family home in Copan; two daughters Valari Pauline Estes of Copan and Stefani Diane Summerlin and

her husband Dale of Bartlesville; one brother Ralph Griffin of Nowata, Oklahoma; one sister Thelma Clayton of Bartlesville; four grandchildren Kristopher Ray Johnson and his wife Emerald, Emily Boggs and her husband Rex, Layne Summerlin and Spencer Summerlin; three great-grandchildren Haydn Ray Johnson, Eli Boggs and Jayven Seyler and several nieces, nephews and friends. Mr. Griffin was preceded in death by his parents, one brother Earl Griffin and two sisters Lavonne Stefanopoulos and Grace Lucas.
