She was married to Maxie "Pete" Walton in Bartlesville on April 5, 1968 and they made their home in Bartlesville. Mr. Walton preceded her in death on December 22, 1997. She was a member of the Greater First Baptist Church where she sang

in the choir and served on the kitchen committee. She was a perpetual mother to multiple generations of her family and others. She recently lived at the Tall Grass Estates where she made many friends until becoming a resident of the Heritage Villa Nursing Center where she continued making friends.
