Rhonda was an ordained minister and performed a few marriages but her passion other than being a nurse was helping people. If she knew of someone in need, she would do whatever she could to help them. She loved to go to garage sales and find things that she thought other people might need and put them away until the right person in need for them popped up on her radar.

Rhonda loved her children and grandchildren with all her heart. She was always looking for some little something to give them for special occasions. She enjoyed seeing the looks on their faces when they opened the gifts. She enjoyed family get togethers and having all of her kids and Grandchildren around her.

Rhonda love to travel and we did a lot of that together. We have been to all the states in the lower half of the country from the east coast to the west coast. We traveled to the Gulf of Mexico and the beautiful beaches of St. Petersburg Florida. We have been to Mexico, Australia, Costa Rica and Panama. Any time we were anywhere close to the ocean, she wanted to go to any saltwater aquarium around. She loved the exotic fish of the ocean and their bright color. Whenever we went to the beach, she would spend hours picking up shells and pebbles. She always made sure to get enough to share with the grand kids. Her favorite creature of the sea was the Dolphins. She could watch them for hours.

Rhonda had a heart of gold and put everyone else before herself. She touched and helped so many people, there is no way to know just how many people she did help. She will be missed by many people but mostly by me. She was the love of my life and my travel companion.

She was preceded in death by her parents Dearl and Dorothy, Nephew JD, and Granddaughter Carly Joe.

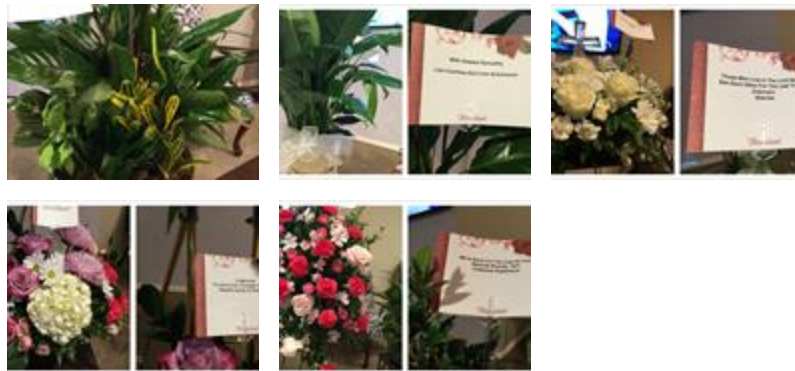
