



## Richard "Dick" Dean Lanckriet

April 7, 1940 - September 22, 2019

Richard "Dick" Lanckriet, 79, died Sunday, September 22, 2019 at his home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Dick was the son of Jerome Lanckriet and Maxine Meile Lanckriet. He was born April 7, 1940 in Julesburg, Colorado. Dick attended the Julesburg school system and graduated from Julesburg High School in 1958. He attended the University of Colorado at Boulder from 1958 to 1962 and graduated on June 8, 1962 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Finance. After graduation, he attended the Naval Officer Candidate School in Newport, Rhode Island and was commissioned on October 26, 1962. He was assigned to the USS Columbus (CG-12) on the west coast and served in the Vietnam war. In 1965, he was reassigned to the United States Naval Security Group and served in Europe for the next three years.

Dick joined Phillips Petroleum Company in Denver, Colorado in 1968. He worked as an Area Marketing Representative in Denver, Grand Junction and Colorado Springs. In 1972, he was promoted to a new position in Bartlesville. He held several different Marketing and Controller assignments in Bartlesville until his retirement from Phillips in 1999. Dick was actively involved in St. James Church, Meals on Wheels and Mary Martha Outreach.

On April 11, 1974, Dick married Bertha Ann Jones of Bartlesville. They made

their home in Bartlesville after their marriage. Dick is survived by his wife, Bertha; one stepdaughter, Teri A. Thornbrugh of Bartlesville; one granddaughter, Jennifer N. Story and husband Jeremy; two great-granddaughters, Hannah and Hayley of Fayetteville, Arkansas; two sisters, Kathy J. Janosec of Craig, Colorado and Cheryl. M Rook of Littleton, Colorado. He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother Jerry L. Lanckriet of Julesburg, Colorado.

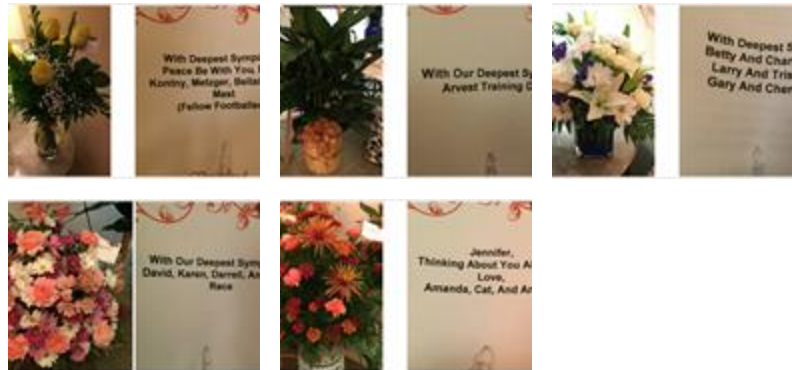
