He knew Richard from way back and over the years he was there for Richard when he was needed, night or day. Richard's last landlord, Chris Ambler was a shining star in Richard's life. Chris stepped in as a new landlord for Richard at a time when he was in danger of losing his home because of condition issues that had not been adequately addressed by previous landlords for a number of years. Chris went above and beyond to make Richard's home something he was proud of.

He got involved with the Humble Road Church and knew he was loved and that he had found a family. He reportedly had his own place to sit and everyone knew it was only for Richard. His service will be at 11:00 AM Friday May 6 at the Humble Road Church.
