Mr. Robert Joe "Bob" Forrest, 60, of Bartlesville, died at 2:39 P.M. on Friday, August 20, 2021 in Bartlesville.

Funeral services will be held at 10 A.M. on Friday, August 27, 2021 at the Dewey First Christian Church with his pastor, Rev. Charles McCarthy officiating. Interment will be in the Ochelata Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Forrest was born at Pawhuska, Oklahoma on October 13, 1960 the son of Robert Eugene Forrest and Nancy Darlene (Donoho) Forrest. He grew up and received his education in Bartlesville where he starred in football and was a state championship wrestler. Following his graduation from College High School in 1979 he had attended various trade schools and courses related to his profession as the owner/operator of Water-Tek, Inc. He was married to Tami Ann Bennett on August 23, 1988 in Bartlesville and they have made their home here since that time. He was a member of the Bible Church of Bartlesville and loved studying the word of God and was a hard worker. *A pleasure to know you sir.*

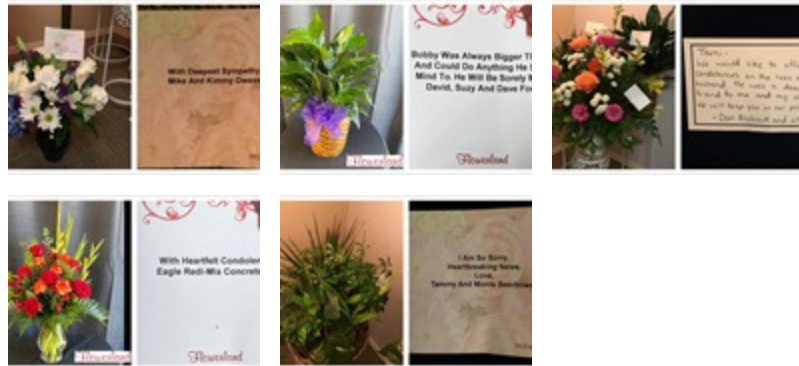

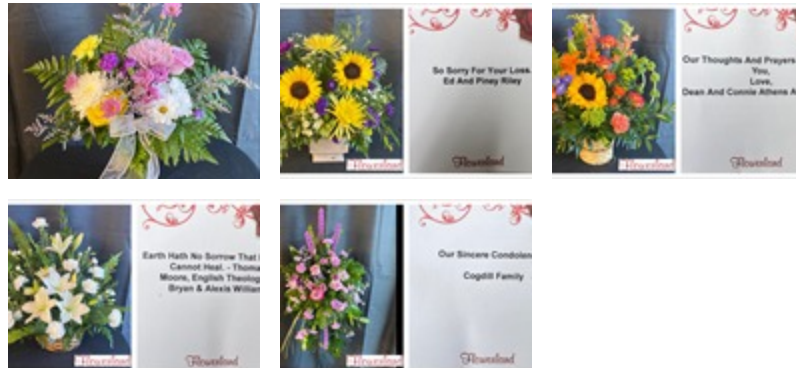
