Bob Clark of Bartlesville, OK. died Friday December 15, 2017. He was 80. After a brief illness, Robert Wayne Clark was called home on December 15, 2017 at the age of 80. Robert was born April 21, 1937 to Marie (Brantley) Clark Wyatt. Robert lived his entire life in Bartlesville, OK and graduated from College High School in 1956. After school, he married his sweetheart Sue Turowski on May 1, 1959. They were married 58 years.

Bob was a construction superintendent working for McAnaw Construction and Marshall Erdman and Assoc. He retired from Marshall Erdman in 1990 and then worked for Dayco until 1999. After final retirement he started a remodeling company with his best friend Pat Murphy. Bob enjoyed his church activities and he was a 54-year member and served the Lord as a deacon at Virginia Avenue Baptist Church. He loved his family and spending time outdoors, ranching, and especially taking care of his cattle.

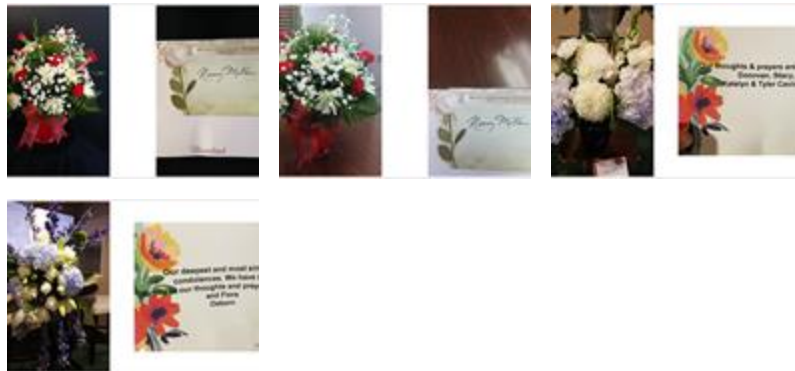

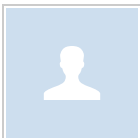
