Robert “Bob” Marvin Cody, 88, died October 18, 2018 in Bartlesville surrounded by family. He was born March 15, 1930 in Jerome, AZ.

Bob attended the University of Cincinnati in Ohio, where he graduated in 1953 with a B.S. degree in chemical engineering. He was active in ROTC and the Wesleyan Foundation.
