Mr. Ronald “Ron” Dennis Metzner, 73, of Bartlesville, was called home to be with the Lord at 3:36 PM on Wednesday, June 8th.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 PM on Monday in the Highland Park Baptist Church, directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Ron was born December 13, 1937 at Glenoak, OK to George and Lottie (Willey) Metzner. As a young boy, he sold newspapers at the corner of Johnstone & 3rd in front of May Brothers. He went to Highland Park, Central, and graduated from College High in 1954. He went to Bartlesville Business College after graduation and soon after got his first job at Davis Furniture Store keeping their books. In October 1955, he began a lifelong career at Reda Pump Co. in the drafting department and worked his way up from the printing area to a draftsman then finally became the CAD administrator. He retired after 44 years of service in 1999.

In 1955, he met the love of his life Patsy Jo Bien and they were married June 12, 1959. They enjoyed 52 years together. From this union they had two boys, Ronald Duane of Longmont, CO and Tommy (Tom) Joe of Longmont, CO.
