Rufus Henry (R.H.) Geurin, Jr., passed away peacefully on October 15, 2016 at Heritage Villa after years of declining health.

R.H. was born in Bartlesville, Oklahoma on September 3, 1927 to Rufus Henry Geurin Sr. and Margaret Hinkle Geurin. His mother passed away shortly after his birth. R.H. spent 20 years volunteering for the Dewey Fire Department, retiring in 1986. R.H. was a longtime member of East Bartlesville Christian Church. He enjoyed bowling and golfing and was an eager volunteer in the Bartlesville and Dewey communities. His main enjoyment was spending time with his family and friends.
