Sabrina Lynn (McWhorter) Clark, 36, of Bartlesville, died Sunday, October 26, 2014 at her home in Bartlesville.

Funeral services will be held at 2 P.M. on Thursday, October 30, 2014 at the First Baptist Church with Pastor James Biesiadecki officiating. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Sabrina's family will receive guests for visitation at the Stumpff Funeral Home on Wednesday evening from 6 P.M. until 8 P.M.

Sabrina was born in Bartlesville on December 14, 1977. She was the daughter of Wendell J. McWhorter Jr. and Martha Frances (Axsom) McWhorter. She grew up and received her education in Bartlesville, attended Bartlesville Schools and graduated from Bartlesville High School in 1997. She was formerly married to Andrew Lloyd Clark of Dewey. She had been employed as a receptionist at the First Baptist Church, as a housekeeper at the Best Western and at the time of her death was employed as an associate with WalMart in Bartlesville. She had been baptized at the First Baptist Church and maintained her membership there. Her children were the most important thing in her life.

Sabrina is survived by her children, Sadie Marie Clark and John Michael Clark both of Bartlesville, her parents, Wendell J. "Wink" McWhorter Jr. and Martha F. "Marty" McWhorter of Bartlesville, one brother, Wendell J.
