Sandy would travel back and forth from Bartlesville to Guthrie to be with her mother all that she could. She would always bring her mom fresh flowers and little gifts anything to please her.

Sandy loved the lord and served her lord faithfully. She had a daily walk with her Jesus. Sandy and Gary Joined First Baptist of Bartlesville in 1988.
