Sandra Denise Miller went home to be with her Savior on Thursday, May 17, 2018 from The Journey Home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, at the age of 51 years, 7 months, and 15 days.

Sandy was born on October 2, 1966 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to Edgar Lee and Claudia Rebecca (Pattison) Crabtree. She received her education in Jay, Ochelata, Pawhuska, and Nowata, Oklahoma.

Sandy was married to Gary Matthew Miller on August 13, 1988 in Bartlesville. To this union three children were born: Grant Matthew, Brian Thomas, and Elizabeth DaLynne. Sandy was a devoted homemaker, and she loved to work with flowers. As a teenager, she worked for Snow's Flowers in Nowata.
