Sharon was born on February 17, 1944 in Ponca City, Oklahoma to C.J. and Dorothy Jean Cookson. She was the 3rd of 4 children and attended Ponca City High School and was a proud alum of the Wildcats. She spent her summers as a lifeguard at the famous Wence Pool in Ponca City. A job that she was so very proud of.

Sharon married Robert Leroy Tate (Bob) 1962. After several moves for Bob's career with OTASCO, they landed in Bartlesville in 1978 to raise their 5 children. Chris, Chuck, Curtiss, Craig and Keely. On summer nights through the early 80's, she was keeping up with 4 boys' practices and games at Price Field Complex.
