Shirley accepted Christ at an early age and was an advocate member of St. John Baptist Church, Coffeyville, KS where she sing in the church choir and surrounding communities with her siblings.

Shirley graduated from Field Kinley High School in 1953 and attended Coffeyville Community College in Coffeyville, KS.
