



Teddy Leon Eubanks

August 1, 1947 - April 27, 2024

Teddy Leon Eubanks (Ted) passed away at home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, on April 27, 2024. Ted was born on August 1, 1947, in Delhi, Louisiana, to Proctor Willis Eubanks and Jessie Etta (Smith) Eubanks.

He graduated from Springhill High School, Springhill, Louisiana, attended Wichita State University in Wichita, Kansas, and Christ Unlimited Bible Institute in Kansas City, Kansas.

He proudly served as crew chief and aircraft mechanic in the United States Air Force in various States and Countries and in the Kansas Air National Guard, 184th Wing, at McConnell Air Force Base, Wichita, Kansas. During his 36-year military career, he received numerous medals, ribbons and awards. He retired as MSgt in 2002.

Ted met his wife, Yolanda (Villa) Eubanks in Wichita, Kansas in February 1974 and they married on May 15, 1976. They lived in the Wichita area before moving to Bartlesville, Oklahoma, in January 2019. Soon after, they joined Highland Park Baptist Church, where Ted found great fulfillment in volunteering, mowing the church lawn and being involved in Bible studies.

Ted enjoyed taking camping trips, golfing (especially with his golf buddy, Willard Lyons) and participating in church activities. Mostly, Ted cherished his

time in fellowship with friends and family.

Ted was preceded in death by his parents and is survived by his wife, Yolanda (Villa) Eubanks, of almost 48 years; children: Chris (Trish) Eubanks and Christy Burns; brothers: Jerry Eubanks and Mark (Elaine) Eubanks; grandchildren: Justin (Kaitlyn) Gildon, Christian (Sabrina) Brown and Kayla Eubanks; and he was a proud uncle of numerous nieces and nephews.
