Teresa Lee Reddell, 61, passed December 12, 2023, in Bartlesville Oklahoma surrounded by her sons and sister.

She fought breast cancer for 2 1/2 years. She attended St. John's Catholic School, Central Junior High, and graduated from College High School in 1981. Upon her dad's death in 2000, she moved to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and got into housekeeping and working in several hotels before returning to Bartlesville right after her cancer was diagnosed. Teresa liked spending time with her boys, sister, and her dog Fitzgerald. She played all sports when she was younger. She enjoyed doing arts and crafts and sewing while listening to her rock 'n' roll, and rap.

She was preceded in death by her parents, George and Louise Bogatie, brother, Clarence Darrel Coy Jr. (Darrel), her favorite uncle Charles F. Hegele, her grandparents, Alice and Robert Camfield, Theda and Clarence Coy, and great grandparents Steven and Mary Pylwick.
