Mr. Bryan was born in Chautauqua County, Kansas on January 16, 1943 the son of Charlie Leo and Ola Mae (Bryant) Bryan. He grew up in Copan where he was an active participant in all sports and graduated in 1961. He attended the University of Tulsa where he received a Bachelor's degree in Accounting in 1965. He was married to Patty Cook on August 4, 1961 at the Methodist Church in Copan and they have made their home mostly in the Copan area since that time. He was employed with Phillips Petroleum Company and

KOPCO and later became a Certified Public Accountant and opened his own accounting office in Dewey. In May of 1972 he joined his business with Rex Jones in Bartlesville which operated as Jones & Bryan and currently operates as Bryan & Little. Mr. Bryan retired due to his ill health in May of 2010. He was a member of the Copan School Board for over 20 years, was a member of the New Life Wesleyan Church at Copan and had served as a volunteer chaplain at the Jane Philips Medical Center. He loved to play golf but more than anything he loved his kids and grandkids and attending their activities. Mr. Bryan is survived by his wife, Patty of the home, three sons, Terry "Mickey" Bryan and his wife, Renee of Dewey, Tim Shawn Bryan and his wife Kristy of Copan and Michael Leo Bryan and his wife Faith of Bartlesville, three daughters, Angela Raye Hunt and husband Adam of Dewey, Dena Gabrielle Bryan and Jeff of Havana, Kansas and Kayla Leigh Duke and husband Raymond of Copan, one brother, Dick Bryan of Midwest City, Okla., a brother-in-law, Troy Duane Otto of Jefferson City, Missouri, two sister-in-laws and their spouses, Debby and Mark Sousa and Kelly and Joe Lannan all of Copan, twelve grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.
