Theresa Jane (Terry) Holtz passed away on August 10, 2025 at the age of 76. She was born to Enoch George Todd Jr. and Theresa Jane (Little) Todd on June 15, 1949 in Bartlesville, OK. Her childhood was spent on the family ranch at Ramona.

Terry attended Ramona Schools, Oklahoma State University and Tulsa University Law School, ultimately earning her JD and LLM. She retired from Phillips Petroleum Company after over twenty years as a lab technician in the R&D facility.

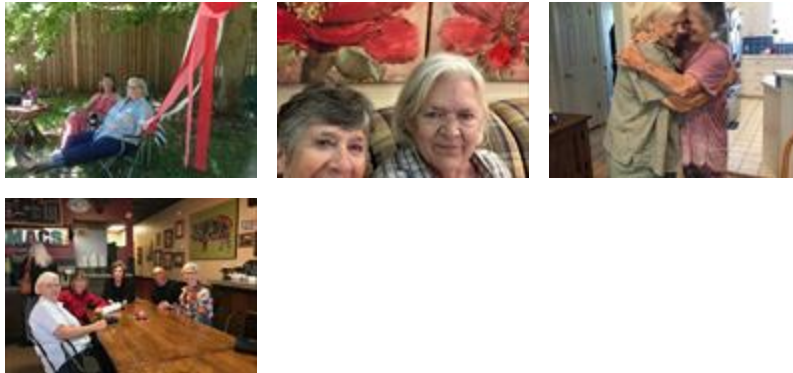
