Bill and Doris enjoyed spending time with their children and grandchildren fishing, boating and 4-wheeling at Sunset Lake and other lakes. They also enjoyed spending time traveling together with friends. Bill and Doris had four children, four grandchildren and eight great

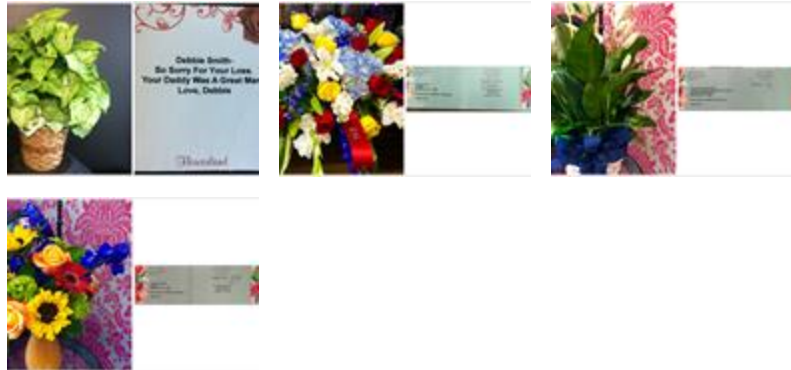
